

INFORMATION ABOUT THE COURSE

COURSE: Classroom phase -- Thirty-six, 50-minute periods given in four-period sessions for nine days.

TIME: 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

LOCATION: James Madison Middle School (near Va. Western Comm. College)
 Turn from Colonial Ave. at the light on McNeil Drive between Va. Western Community College and Fishburn Park Elem. School. Turn right after the baseball field and proceed to the upper parking area.

INSTRUCTORS: All classroom and in-car instruction is provided by professional educators with experience in the Roanoke area Public School Systems.

CREDENTIALS: Licensed by the Department of Motor Vehicles

FEES:

Driver Education Classroom Phase \$125.00
 A \$25.00 **non-refundable** deposit should be sent with the enclosed Application. The balance of \$100.00 is payable the first day of class. Pro-rated refunds will be provided upon request for students unable to complete our classroom program. Fees include textbook usage. All textbooks must be returned in good condition upon completion of the course. (There will be a \$60.00 fee for lost books and a \$10.00 returned check fee.)

Behind-the-Wheel Phase \$275.00* (with class)
 Payable in advance; a total of 14, 50-minute periods -- 7 periods of behind-the-wheel and 7 periods as an observer, given in two-period sessions for seven days. Students drive a minimum of 100 miles.

Students are scheduled for behind-the-wheel training after we receive payment. There is normally a waiting period for this phase of driver training. Priority is given to students closer to license eligibility. We schedule driving for after-school hours, Saturday mornings, and during school holidays. We require a 24-hour cancellation notice when a student cannot attend a scheduled driving period. There will be a \$25.00 fee for students who fail to cancel an appointment. Students are responsible for re-scheduling missed appointments. Behind-the-Wheel fees will be refunded should we fail to provide that service in a reasonable time period. If a student does not pass the driving test on the first or second try, there will be a \$25.00 charge for the third and each additional test.


ATTENDANCE POLICY:

Attendance is mandatory and students are expected to be on time. Students who miss a class must attend a make-up class as assigned by the instructor. There will be a \$25.00 fee for students to attend the make-up class. Students failing to meet the attendance requirements will not successfully complete the class. In that event, the student may re-enroll in a future class or request a pro-rated refund of class fees.

UPON COMPLETION:

Students who successfully complete our driver training program will receive DMV Form DTS B. Once the student turns 16 years, 3 months, has had a learner's permit for 9 months, and upon parental consent (signature)*, the DTS B certificate, accompanied by a learner's permit, serves as a 180-day temporary license. During that 180-day period, students who were under the age of 18 at the time the learner's permit was issued will be notified to appear before a judge to receive their permanent license. Students who were 18 at the time the learner's permit was issued will go to the DMV for their driver's license.

*When parents sign the DTS B form, they are certifying that they have driven 45 hours with their child, 15 of those hours being after sunset.

DMV NOTES:

Students 18 years of age and under are required to complete a state approved driver's education program prior to receiving a driver's license. Students 19 years of age and older may hold their learner's permit for 30 days in lieu of completing a driver training course.

The instruction provided does not guarantee that any student will pass the state license examination or that the student can secure a license, or that the student will be guaranteed employment upon completion of the course.

It is the responsibility of the student, or in the case of a minor, the parent or legal guardian, to report to the Department of Motor Vehicles any concerns regarding school facilities, instructor behavior or quality of instruction by the school.

Students under 18 years of age may receive one-on-one driver training with an instructor if such training is agreed to by the parent or guardian. The student is required to meet the observation requirements with at least one other student in the vehicle during in-vehicle training.

Normally, there are 2 students in the car, each driving and observing a 50-minute session. Occasionally, with parental permission, a third student can join 2 students during the last observation period. The third student would observe for 50 minutes and then the original 2 students would be taken home. The third student would remain with the instructor and drive for 50 minutes. This option for Behind-the-Wheel is helpful for students with time constraints because of band, sports, work or travel. Also, when there are long waiting lists, we can drive with 3 students after school instead of only 2. Parents should only sign permission if they want their child to have this option.
